

HOOBIE MEETING #2

We had our quarterly meeting Wednesday, August 16, 2006 at 6:30 with dinner and 7:15pm meeting at the Quality Inn. There were 18 members present and one guest.

Tommy Brite, vice-president open the meeting.

The minutes of the May 31, 2006 meeting were passed out. A motion by Bill Williams and seconded by Phil Rhodes to accept the minutes as written. Motion carried.

David Twiford gave a report on the membership and treasurer's report.

Following the treasurer's report, Tommy Brite turned the meeting over to Terry Waterfield, Chairman of the Rules Committee.

Chairman Waterfield talked a little about the by-laws. James Reel made a motion, seconded by Bud Tardiff to accept the by-laws as written with one exception; Section #7—to change a legal quorum at any meeting to be at least **20%** of total voting membership. Motion carried.

Chairman Waterfield talked about the members playing from different tees. The Rules Committee had met earlier this month and decided to do away with the age limit as to which tees a person could play and let the members play any tee they choose, but must remain on the particular set of tees until “the time changes”. At the present time, while everyone is still adjusting to a particular set of tees to play, one can still move from one set of tees to another set (**only once**) but needs to let David Twiford know so he can adjust the person's average score to reflect same. Reason for not being able to keep switching back and forth to different tees, it affects the team's bet.

Rules Committee brought up about playing the ball down from tee to green (summer rules). A lot of discussion followed. A motion to play “summer rules” until Daylight Savings Times ends was made by Phil Rhoades, seconded by J.J. Twiford. Motion carried. Beginning tomorrow, August 17, 2006, the ball must be played as it lies. If a person intentionally or unintentionally moves his or her ball, a two-stroke penalty will occur. **It is up to everyone to call a penalty whether it is on yourself or a teammate when an infraction occurs.** This is the only way for the rule to work properly.

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Phil Rhoades talked about having a “fun day” each month, where everyone on a particular day will play from the black tees or blue tees. This suggestion was sent to the Rules Committee to discuss and come up with a suggestion to be presented at our next regular meeting.

Chairman Waterfield thanked everyone and turned the meeting back over to Vice President Brite. Tommy Brite went around the room and asked everyone if there were any issues that needed to be discussed. James Reel expressed disappointment in how the tournaments are being handled. He has discussed this with Bill Taylor and David Mascitti, but seems to have falling on “deaf ears”. Also, James expressed disappointment in the restaurant atmosphere and the exorbitant prices that are being charged. It was suggested that President Bill Summerour and Vice President Tommy Brite request a meeting with Bill Taylor to discuss our concerns and offer some suggestions.

No further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50pm. Our next scheduled meeting will be held in October or a special-called meeting could be sooner if the Board deems necessary.
