

**HOOBIES ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING**

We had our Organizational meeting, Wednesday, May 31, 2006 at 7:15pm at the Marina Restaurant. There were 21 members present.

Sam T. presided at the meeting. After welcoming everyone, Sam opened the floor for the Election of Officers for the coming year.

Officers elected were as follows:

Following the Election of Officers, Terry Waterfield read the recommendations from the Rules Committee. Each item was read, discussed, voted upon and adopted as written.

- A. Annual dues of \$25.00---due each January beginning 2007, however dues for 2006 are NOW due.
- B. Every member of the Hoobies should be in the Pines' handicap system.
- C. Minimum bet of \$2.00 per person-per point when there are 12 golfers or less. Over 12 players the minimum bet would be \$1.00 per person-per point. **EACH** player on the team must bet at least the minimum.

- D. **Winter rules** would apply as how we played the game. (Move the ball one club length in own fairway). If you cannot determine if you are in or out of the fairway, you must play the ball down and not move it.
- E. Anyone wishing to play with the Hoobies (regulars or invited guest must be 18 years old or older.
- F. Non-members of the Hoobies will be allowed to play with the group only once every quarter. If they want to play more with the Hoobies, they **MUST** join and pay the \$25.00 annual dues. This does not apply to anyone living outside of Pasquotank Co., Perquimans Co., Gates Co. and Camden Co.
- G. Anyone wanting to play with the Hoobies **MUST** be invited by a member of the Hoobies to play.
- H. Members can choose different tees to play from, but must remain on that particular tee until the change of time from Daylight Savings Time to EST or vice-versa. Members 65 or younger may play from the Blue or White Tee. Members 66-75 can select to play from Blue, White or Green tees. Any Hoobie over 75 ay play from any set of tees they wish to play from. Any female that is a member of the Hoobies can select to play from any set of tees.

Following the rules committee report, Sam T. pass out a set of Proposed By-Laws for the Hoobies to be discussed and adopted at our next meeting in July.
